



A Message from Dentistry for Children

To our patients and families,

We wanted to send an update from our office. Following the recommendation from the American Dental Association, the Idaho State Dental Association, and local authorities we are only treating urgent and emergency cases until May 1st. While we are complying with that guidance, we are also actively planning to see patients again on May 1st.

As we start seeing patients again, we will follow the recommendations for safety and practice from the ADA and the CDC. It is our ultimate goal to keep our staff and our patients safe and healthy as we begin providing treatment again.

We will be 1) limiting the number of people in the office to the patient and one parent accompanying them, 2) confirming that all our staff and patients are currently healthy so as not to put others in the office at risk, and 3) using the recommended personal protection equipment (PPE) and barriers that are appropriate and provide the highest safety for our office.

With fewer patients being seen in the office, we will need to be creative in finding time to see all of you that we have missed during the closure. We will be adding time to expand the schedule so we appreciate you being flexible and patient with us. Please be assured that we are working really hard to get you back into the schedule so we can continue to care for your dental needs.
